Visit the beautiful small island of Uzi in the south of Zanzibar, where you can still find a piece of original Zanzibar, untouched by large-scale tourism. We want it to stay like this as long as possible and are therefore only promoting and operating a form of tourism on Uzi island which respects and involves the people of Uzi, and which supports the conservation of the island's environment.

On our Uzi island day trip, you will move around Uzi on an oxcart - just like a local. This is great fun and we are caring really well for Kipole, our oxen.

The trip will start at the mangrove area where you will learn about the ecological importance of the mangroves. Then, at the village, you will see many aspects of traditional island life. At the village kindergarten you will have the chance to interact with some cheerful island kids. We will also enter a local house and have a seafood and vegetable lunch cooked by the housewife.

We will then visit the sea turtle conservation project on Uzi's west coast. Small and vulnerable sea turtles are being grown to be released into the ocean when they are bigger and stronger. The nearby beach is a heaven for birdlovers. Over 40 species can be observed. Our last stop is the seaweed farming project.
